How Long Does It Take to Adopt a Newborn in the United States?

The answer depends on who you ask and their experience. Three to ten years is the general estimate and, yes, this is true if you go through the public system or some traditional private agencies.

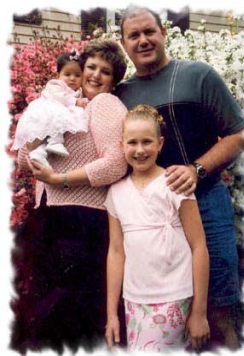
